MINUTES

The Tom Green County Bail Bond Board met on Wednesday, July 16, 2025 in the County Commissioner's court room.

Item Number 1 was to call the meeting to order and the determination of a quorum. Board Chair Dianna Spieker called the meeting to order at 11:00AM and Louie Perez acknowledged that a quorum was present.

Item Number 2 was the Consent Agenda. This consisted of the (a) Minutes from the May 21, 2025 meeting and the (b) Bond Issuance Monthly Report. Judge Stacye Speck made a motion to approve as presented. Jason Sosa seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Item Number 3 was to consider any submitted renewal bail bond applications within the 30-day window. 3(a) Alliance Bail Bonds. 3(b) Concho Bail Bonds 3(c) Freedom Bail Bonds II and 3(d) Jenkins A Action Bail Bonds were under this agenda item. The applications were presented by Dianna Spieker and announced that all criteria have been submitted satisfactorily and there were no issues for any of the aforementioned companies. Jason Sosa made a motion to approve the renewal applications as presented. Judge Stacye Speck seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Item Number 4 was Audits. Jaime Vance reported that audits for 4(a) Angelo Bail Bonds 4(b) Freedom Bail Bonds II and 4(c) Jenkins A Action Bail Bonds were in compliance and there were no findings. Dianna Spieker made a motion to approve the audits. Taylor Younts seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Item Number 5 was to consider a committee to rewrite our renewal application procedures. The committee will consist of Jason Sosa, Taylor Younts and Louie Perez.

Item Number 6 a briefing from the bail bond companies. The bail bondsmen had a meeting to review and update some of the bail bond forms, especially the record requirement sheet and receipts. An update and list of the license renewals coming up were discussed with an emphasis on the new and revised application updates. Lastly, succession plans for bail bond companies thinking about estate planning and future operations were discussed and would like to be put on the future agenda.

Item Number 7 was Public Comment. None at this time.

Item Number 8 was Future Agenda Items. Succession or Estate Planning for bail bond companies.

Item Number 9 is the Next Meeting Date. The next meeting dates will be on 08/20/2025, 09/17/2025 (if necessary) and a required meeting on 10/16/2025.

Item Number 10 was Adjournment. Dianna adjourned the meeting at 11:12 AM.
