

MAY NOT BE USED FOR COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE

1. Get your SR-22 from your car insurance company and bring it to the Judge's office along with the petition/order and your money orders.

2. A hearing may be set to determine if you are eligible to receive an Occupational Driver's License. At that time the Judge will either grant/deny you an occupational driver's license. You must tell her/him your occupation, your driver's license number, and what date your license was suspended.

3. If the Judge grants a driver's license, then you must take it to the **County Clerk's office** for filing. **It will cost you approximately \$261.00(cash or credit card)** (\$245.00 filing fee plus \$5.00 each for two certified copies plus \$1.00 for each page certified).

4. The Order must then be filed with the County Clerk's Office. You will receive two certified copies of the Order and the Petition. Mail one set to the DPS and keep the other set for yourself. You must have a certified copy of the Order and Petition on your person for the entire period that your regular license is suspended.

If you do not receive your Occupational Driver's License (ODL) from the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) before the 45th day after the date this Order takes effect, you MUST not drive until you receive your ODL from DPS or come back to court to get an Amended Order for your ODL that extends the 45-day time period.

The Court ORDERS that this Petition for Occupational Driver's License is GRANTED subject to the following restrictions listed below:

During the effective term of this order, Petitioner shall not operate a motor vehicle in a public place while having any detectable amount of alcohol, a controlled substance, a drug, or a combination of two or more of these substances in the Petitioner's system.

___ Any personal vehicle owned or operated by Petitioner MUST be equipped with a working ignition interlock device. A person may operate a motor vehicle without an interlock if they are required to operate a motor vehicle in the course and scope of employment and the vehicle is owned by employer.

___ Petitioner must not refuse any lawful request by law enforcement for a sample of Petitioner's breath or blood if Stopped for Driving While Intoxicated

___ Petitioner must submit to periodic/random testing for alcohol or controlled substances as follows:

___ Petitioner must attend the alcohol/drug counseling program listed below and submit proof of attendance.

___ Petitioner must submit to Community Supervision as follows:

___ Petitioner must only drive to/from work, school, and other essential duties to include Medical appointments, Court appointments, attorney appointments, probation office meetings, and any supervision, education, counseling, or other essential needs authorized by this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall be required to give proof of a valid policy of auto liability insurance in accordance with the Texas State Safety Responsibility Law. This order valid until _____.
