

13.004 REQUEST FOR VOTER REGISTRATION RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY

Pursuant to Section 13.004 of the Election Code, if you are one of the qualifying individuals listed in Step 2, below, you may request that information in the voter registration records identifying your residence address be restricted from public access. By completing and submitting this form to the County Voter Registrar's Office (<http://www.sos.texas.gov/elections/voter/votregduties.shtml>), you are requesting the confidentiality of the voter registration information as stated above. You must attach a photocopy of documentation showing that you are eligible for confidentiality. If you want to rescind this confidentiality request, you must do so in writing to the County Voter Registrar's Office.
