A RESOLUTION APPROVING A JOINT ELECTION SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS AND CHRISTOVAL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Christoval Independent School District (the "District") has called for a School Trustee election to be held on November 5, 2024, to be managed by the Tim Green County Election Officer (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, the County has indicated an interest in conducting a joint election with the District for its election to be held on November 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the public interest to enter into a joint election agreement and election services contract with the County, to enable eligible District voters to use common polling locations, election officers, and provide for the most efficient and convenient voting opportunities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVE BY THE CHRISTOVAL COUNTY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

- Sections 1. The District does hereby agree to participate in a joint election with the County, pursuant to Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, in accordance with the terms and conditions established in "Exhibit A", which is incorporated herein as if fully set forth;
- Section 2. The joint election shall take place on November 5, 2024;
- Section 3. The joint election shall allow eligible District residents to vote for the Christoval Independent School District trustee elections and allow District voters to vote in the County elections;
- Section 4. Each entity shall share in the expense for operating the elections, in accordance with the cost-sharing agreement to be worked out between the parties through their authorized representatives; and that the District's Superintendent shall be the authorized representative of the District and is authorized to agree to pay for all or any portion of such expenses and to agree to any other joint election activities, if any, that the Superintendent finds is in the best interest of the District;
- Section 5. The meeting at which this Resolution was considered was open to the public and public notice of the time, placed and purpose of the meeting was given and posted, as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended;
- Section 6. This Resolution is effective immediately form and after the date of its passage, and it is so enacted.
