THE PRECINCT IT IS IN 300(PRECINCT 3) THEN THE NUMERICAL ORDER THAT IS BEING ADDED FOR THAT PRECINCT. PR 301(PRIVATE ROAD 301, FIRST PRIVATE ROAD ADDED TO THE MSAG FOR PRECINCT 3)

THE PURPOSED CHANGE TO THE PROCEDURES OF NUMBERING THE PRIVATE ROADS ENABLES THE COMMISSIONERS AND 911 ADDRESSING TO ADD ROADS TO THE MSAG WITH OUT THE POSSIBILITY OF RELEASING CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION SUCH AS THE LOCATION OF A PERSONS RANCH OR ADDRESS BECAUSE NO NAME WILL BE USED ON A PRIVATE ROAD.
