Tom Green County Commissioner's Court Special Called Meeting –September 30, 2002

The Tom Green County Commissioners' Court met in a Special Session in the Commissioners' Court Room of the Edd B. Keyes Building Monday, September 30, 2002 with the following present:

Clayton Friend, Commissioner Precinct #1 Karl Bookter, Commissioner Precinct #2 Jodie R. Weeks, Commissioner Precinct #3 Richard Easingwood, Commissioner Precinct #4 Michael D. Brown, County Judge

- 1. **Judge Brown** called the meeting to order at 3:40 P.M.
- 2. Commissioner Easingwood moved to <u>rescind the October 14, 2002 Columbus Day, and reinstate November 11, 2002----Veteran's Day, as the County Holiday for FY 2003.</u> Commissioner Friend seconded the motion and all voted in favor.
- 3. Following a lengthy discussion regarding the liability issues, and following a presentation made by Blake Adair on behalf of the Christoval student body, Philip Montalvo, Christoval VFD, presented proof of liability insurance for Dove Creek VFD.
 - Judge Brown moved to grant the request by Christoval Volunteer Fire Department and the Dove Creek Volunteer Fire Department to have a combined fire training exercise of a controlled burn on County owned land across near Pugh Park on October 3, 2002. Commissioner Weeks seconded the motion. Commissioners Friend, Bookter & Weeks and Judge Brown voted in favor of the motion. Commissioner Easingwood voted against the motion. The motion passed 4 to 1.
- **4.** There was a lengthy discussion about the division of road equipment and the percentages of designated funds from specific precincts toward purchases new or different equipment. All surplus pickups or other equipment not being used will be sold at the December Auction.

There was no action taken by the Court at this time.

5. Judge Brown moved to have Robert Elliott appraise the Standard Times parking lot on the corner of Martin Luther King and College Street. Commissioner Friend seconded the motion and all voted in favor.
