The Tom Green County Commissioners' Court met in a Special Session in the Commissioners' Court Room of the Edd B. Keyes Building Wednesday September 19, 2003 with the following present:

1. **Judge Brown** called the meeting to order at 9:27A.M.
2. Molly Taylor, Elections Administrator, informed the Court that there were no hand counted ballots. All ballots were machine counted. All proposed propositions Passed statewide. Ms. Taylor informed the Court that a DRE (touch screen) voting machine would have to be purchased for each voting precinct to be in compliance with HAVA (Help America Vote Act). Judge Brown requested Ms. Taylor to check into the cost of possibly full conversion of voting machines.

Judge Brown moved to approve the Canvass of the Constitutional Amendment Election, held on the 13th day of September 2003 in Tom Green County and certify that the total of all votes received “for” and “against” each measure is shown by the precinct returns. Commissioner Friend seconded the motion and all voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
