- 10. Commissioner Bookter moved to authorize the County to pay the deductible amount of \$25,000.00 in the Settlement Agreement of a legal suit (Dog Case). Commissioner Friend seconded the motion and all voted in favor.
- 11. Commissioner Friend moved to award RFB 04-022 "Prescription Drugs for Inmates" to Pharmacy Unlimited. Commissioner Friend withdrew his motion pending additional information that was questioned.
- 8. Judge Brown moved to adopt the Resolution designating May as "Mental Health Month". Commissioner Weeks seconded the motion and all voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
- 11. Commissioner Friend restated his motion to award RFB 04-022 "Prescription Drugs for Inmates" to Pharmacy Unlimited. Commissioner Weeks seconded the motion and all voted in favor. (Filed with these minutes.)
- 5. She reported that she has not had any recent communication with the Veribest ISD. There will be a new Superintendent at Veribest this next year. **No action.**

### 2004 Mental Health Month Resolution

WHEREAS, May is designated, as "Mental Health Month;" and

WHEREAS, approximately 3 million Texans will suffer from some form of mental illness, and mental illness does not distinguish among those it affects: the rich and poor; old and young; male and female; Hispanic, African-American, White, Asian, and; friends and relatives; and

WHEREAS, there are situations where stigma, rooted in fear and lack of understanding, has prevented persons with mental illness from receiving the services that could help them live independently, has discouraged some persons with mental illness from seeking services in any setting, has prevented families from receiving the support and understanding they need to keep their family member with them in the community; has prevented children from reaching their full potential; has led to the placement of many elderly persons in long-term care facilities that are inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, most mental illnesses can be treated, symptoms can be alleviated, dysfunctional behaviors and thinking patterns that once crippled can now be corrected, and most persons with mental illness with support can live productive and fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, a certain percentage of persons with mental illness will experience ongoing symptoms of mental illness which will keep them from safety living independently in the community; and intensive services in the state hospitals will continue to be needed and be improved; and

WHEREAS, today's research is opening new insights into the causes, treatment, and possible prevention of mental illness and bringing new hope to the lives of persons with mental illness; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Tom Green County Commissioners' Court is pleased to recognize "Mental Health Month" as a means of promoting an understanding of mental illness that will lessen stigma, reduce fear, and result in more persons with mental illness having the opportunity to live in the most appropriate setting possible and function to their fullest possible capacity.

WHEREAS, TOM GREEN COUNTY supports efforts to promote hazard mitigation in the thirteen (13) county area known as the Concho Valley region through the development of the Concho Valley Hazard Mitigation Action Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TOM GREEN COUNTY:

That the COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TOM GREEN COUNTY supports and endorses efforts to develop a regional hazard mitigation action plan as required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Texas Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management to remain eligible for federal post-disaster recovery assistance for all local disasters occurring after November 1, 2004. Further, the COMMISSIONERS' COURT supports naming the Concho Valley Council of Government's Emergency Preparedness Advisory Committee as the point of contact and working subcommittee on matters concerning hazard mitigation.
