The Commissioners' Court of Tom Green County, Texas, met in Regular Session January 25, 2005 in the Edd B. Keyes Building, with the following members present:

Ralph Hoelscher, Commissioner of Precinct #1 Karl Bookter, Commissioner of Precinct #2 Absent Steve Floyd, Commissioner of Precinct #3 Richard Easingwood, Commissioner of Precinct #4 Michael D. Brown, County Judge

- 1. County Judge, Michael Brown, called the meeting to order at 8:05 A.M.
- 2. Judge Brown recessed the Open Meeting to go into a Closed Executive Session in accordance with V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 551, subchapter D.
- 5. Judge Brown reconvened the meeting in Open Session at 8:58 A.M.
- 6. The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States and the Texas Flags was recited. Judge Brown offered the invocation.
- 8. Commissioner Easingwood moved to accept the Consent Agenda as amended. Commissioner Floyd seconded the motion. The following items were presented:

- D. Acknowledged the Treasurer's certificate certifying compliance in investment hours for calendar year 2004. (Recorded with these minutes)
- E. Acknowledged the donation of a Dell Dimension P3 600 Mhz processor with 256 MB RAM, Win 98 operating system, 20 GB Hard drive and CD-Rom from Dr. Thomas Marsden for use in the Crisis Intervention Unit.
- F. Authorized the purchasing of a vehicle from the Department of Public Safety for use in the Sheriff's Office.
- G. Granted request for permission to Concho Rural Water Corporation to:
 - Install a 4 inch water line across Door Key Road at the intersection of Highway 277 South;
 - Install a 6 inch water line in the right-of-way of the County road in the North Concho River Estates Subdivision beginning at Tract 14 and continue North for 5730 feet on the west side of Deer Run to the intersection of Buck Hollow Loop.

(Van Carson and AJ Jones expressed their concerns, for the record, that the water would be taken from the South Concho River, which is a source of the San Angelo water supply.)

All present voted in favor of the motion as amended.

- 9. There was no action on any matters discussed in Closed/Executive Session.
- 10. Judge Brown moved to approve the Library remodel design development documents and proceed with the construction documents phase contingent upon the approval by the Library Board. Judge Brown, Commissioner Hoelscher and Commissioner Easingwood voted in favor of the motion. Commissioner Bookter was absent and Commissioner Floyd abstained. The motion passed. (Recorded with these minutes)
- 11. Commissioner Floyd moved to adopt the Resolution recognizing the following persons as appointed to the Water Valley Pioneer Cemetery Advisory Board: Chair person- Jarrel Millican, Vice Chair Person- Nona Williams, Treasury Tommy Earnest, Secretary Jacquelyn Anderson, Member Charlotte Williams. Judge Brown seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
- 12. Judge Brown moved to enter into an Interlocal Agreement between Tom Green County and Runnels County for provision of services of the Tom Green County Veterans Service Officer at a prorated amount of \$8,000.00 with the agreement that all Tom Green County percentage increases in salary will also be done in Runnels County. Commissioner Floyd seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.
- 13. Archie Kountz reported that the Insurance committee has met and discussed issues and proposals for the upcoming year. They are looking into coordinating some services with the City in order to provide more benefits while saving money for both entities. No action was taken.
- 14. Commissioner Floyd moved to award RFP 05-008 "New Model 15 Passenger Van" to Jim Bass Ford of San Angelo in the amount of \$17,935.00 to be used by the Veteran's Service Office. Judge Brown seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)

- 15. Commissioner Hoelscher moved to award RFP 05-009 "State Grade and The Regular Meeting of the Tom Green County Commissioners' Court was recessed at 11:45 A.M. to hold Rock" to CSA Materials, Inc. as specified on spreadsheet. Commissioner Floyd seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
- 16. Commissioner Floyd moved to authorize the Park Superintendent to purchase a Bradco rock bucket for a skid steer loader from Warren Caps at a price not to exceed \$1,380.00 as presented. Commissioner Easingwood seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.
- 17. Judge Brown moved to adopt a Resolution approving the submission of a grant application for the Cluster Collections Pilot Project to the Office of the Governor. Commissioner Hoelscher seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
- 18. Commissioner Easingwood moved to accept the County Treasurer's Report for December 2004 as presented. Commissioner Hoelscher seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (Recorded with these minutes.)
- 19. Commissioner Easingwood moved that the 2005 Grievance Committee be composed of nine-public members, in accordance with Local Government Code 152.014 (a) (2), drawn from the Grand Jury Pool and to be activated in accordance with 152.016 (b) (2). Judge Brown seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.
- 20. Commissioner Hoelscher moved that the Tom Green County Commissioners' Court become the sponsoring entity, by appointing a Riverbank Stabilization Committee that would include members of other interested agencies and groups, in seeking assistance to finance a program to aid land and property owners with the removal of dead trees along the banks of the Concho and other area rivers. Judge Brown seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.

A.J. Jones expressed his concerns about the safety issues involved with the dead trees and the damage that could be caused to bridges, culverts, low water crossings and the water flow. He also expressed his support for the project and commended the court for their involvement. He suggested that the trees should be cut at the base and retain the root system to avoid erosion.

Judge Brown suggested that the Ad hock Committee for Riverbank Stabilization be appointed at the February 8th, 2005 meeting.

- 21. Judge Brown acknowledged the acceptance five commemorative plaques inscribed with the names and terms of the entire Tom Green County Commissioners 'Court Members since 1874 to hang henceforth in the Commissioners' Courtroom. Commissioner Easingwood seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.
- 22. The only issue discussed d relating to the Tom Green County Subdivision and Manufactured Home Rental Community Development Regulations was regarding the acceptance of flag lots. There was a discussion in March of 2000 at a workshop to add the 100 feet frontage language to the regulations and there was some question as to whether there was a motion to that effect. County Clerk, Elizabeth McGill will review the tapes for a confirmation. The appointed Committee recommending the rules regarding revising the regulations will also review the discussions. No action was taken.

AJ Jones requested to be on record as recommending that the regulations require the supply source for water availability on future subdivisions.

- 23. There were no line item transfers for FY2005.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Tom Green County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tom Green County, that the Cluster Collections Pilot Project be operated for the period beginning on March 1, 2005 and ending on August 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the project is a statewide project, which will include one host county with a formal fine collections program and seven rural counties without formal fine collections programs; and

WHEREAS, Tom Green County agrees to serve as the host county and to hire and provide quarters to a collections officer and a collections clerk who will provide collections services for the county court and the justice courts in each of the following counties: Coke, Concho, Irion, Menard, Runnels, Schleicher, and Sterling counties (hereinafter referred to as the "Tom Green County Cluster").

WHEREAS, the commissioners court of each county agreeing to participate in the project is responsible only for providing the county's portion of the matching funds required for the project, as designated below; and

WHEREAS, the Tom Green County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for state assistance for said project, in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 for the total statewide project costs, and authorizes the administrative director of the state Office of Court Administration to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Tom Green County Commissioners Court agrees that Tom Green County participate in the pilot project, with matching funds to be provided by Coke County in the amount of \$602.06, Concho County in the amount of \$2,161.25, Irion County in the amount of \$725.56, Menard County in the amount of \$1,250.44, Runnels County in the amount of \$632.94, Schleicher County in the amount of \$1,265.88, and Sterling County in the amount of \$1,080.63, which totals \$7,718.75 and is the amount equal to one-fourth of the costs attributable to the participation of the Tom Green County Cluster in the project; and

WHEREAS, the Tom Green County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Tom Green County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tom Green County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Cluster Collections Pilot Project to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

Fed Ends the Year Hiking its Overnight Rate 25 Basis Points

The Federal Reserve ended 2004 by increasing its overnight fed funds rate 25 basis points to close the year at a 2.25 percent rate. This move was largely expected and the Fed did not make any major changes to its policy statement. For the year, the funds rate was increased a total of 125 basis points in 25-basis point increments initiated at the end of June. Inflation pressures still appear to be "contained" as we go into 2005, and the Fed intends to continue removing its "accommodative" rate stance until it approaches the elusive "neutral" rate. The neutral rate is the rate the Fed seeks to maintain in order to neither stimulate nor restrain economic growth and is considered to be anywhere from 3-5 percent. This will be a theme the markets will be contemplating during the duration of 2005.

The value of the U.S. dollar may have an impact on global interest rates. The dollar fell to new historical lows against the euro in December and also declined versus the Japanese yen. This decline is expected to continue into the first quarter of 2005 as none of

the governments involved have any immediate plans to prop up their currencies. If the dollar continues to decline, there could be some pressure on markets if foreign banks do not want to incur losses on the currency, potentially selling off Treasuries and driving up interest rates. Energy prices and geopolitical concerns will also be on the radar screen for investors in 2005.

The FOMC will meet February 1-2, 2005. Economic statistics to watch in January are ISM (1/3), employment (1/7), Retail Sales (1/13), Producer Price Index (1/14), Industrial Production (1/14), Consumer Price Index (1/19), Housing Starts (1/19), Durable Goods Orders (1/27) and Gross Domestic Product (1/28).

As of December 31, 2004, the Dow was up approximately 3.9 percent for the month, and up 3.14 percent for the year. The NASDAQ was up 3.75 percent for the month and ended the year up 8.6 percent. The S&P 500 finished December up 3.25 percent for the month and finished the year up 9.0 percent.

Sector Review

U.S. Treasuries: In our Treasury portfolios, we are keeping our weighted average maturities (WAM) in the low- to mid-30 day range. The front end of the yield curve should continue to steepen as the Fed is expected to continue raising rates during 2005. At year end, three-month bills yielded 2.12 percent, six-month bills yielded 2.58 percent, two-year Treasuries yielded 3.07 percent, 10-year Treasuries yielded 4.22 percent and 30-year bonds yielded 4.83 percent.

Repurchase Agreements: Overnight repurchase agreements (repo) started the month trading at 2.05 percent, traded as high as 2.34 percent during the month, then wilted to the 1.50 percent to 2.00 percent range at month-end (depending upon the collateral). This is not unusual during the year end period as overnight cash was in low demand. Repo should trade at 2.25 percent during January.

Commercial Paper: The short-term yield curve steepened slightly in December. One-month commercial paper (CP) was being issued

at 2.35 percent as year end demand for that maturity pushed rates to attractive levels. Three-month CP was being issued at 2.47 percent and six-month CP was being issued at 2.65 percent. On a relative value basis, U.S. government agency paper is trading at attractive levels compared to top-tier commercial paper as Fannie Mae continues to struggle with its reporting issues. Given the tight spreads, we will underweight CP versus discount notes and are keeping our investments on the shorter end of the curve, maintaining WAMs in the low 30s.

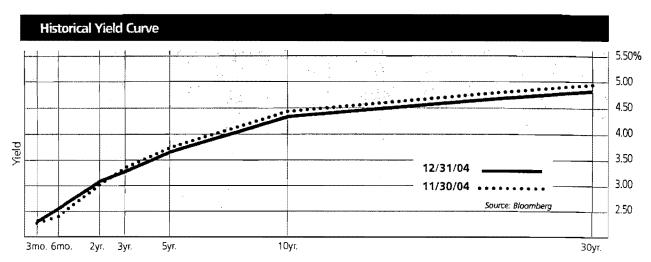
U.S. Government Agencies: Fannie Mae continues to irritate the market as it tries to rectify its upper management difficulties and fiscal reporting issues. We are targeting WAMs in the low 30s since the front end of the money market curve continues to have better relative value in a rising rate environment. At month's end, discount notes were trading at 2.20 percent in the one-month area, 2.45 percent for three-month securities and 2.63 percent for sixmonth securities. The front end of the curve is still more attractive than the longer end of the curve.
