



Today, over 130 years since Tom Green County was created, our citizens are still answering the call to service.

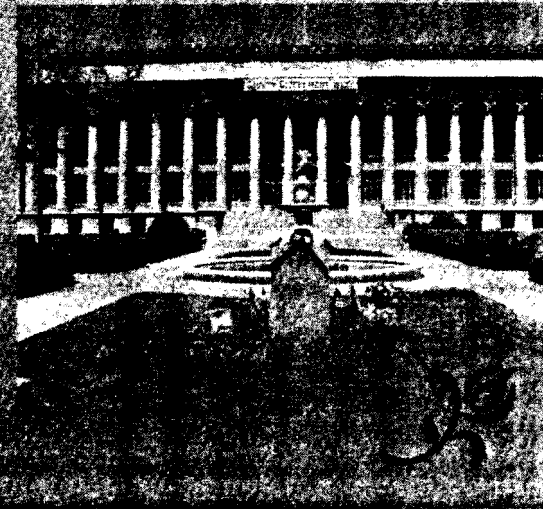
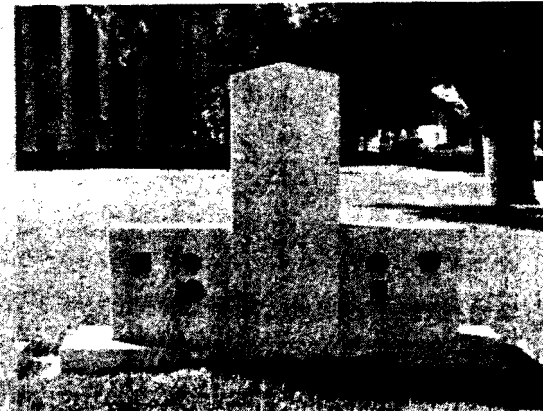

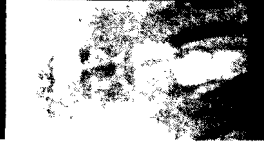
Tom Green, Citizen, Patriot, Veteran of Battle of San Jacinto & later famous CSA General.

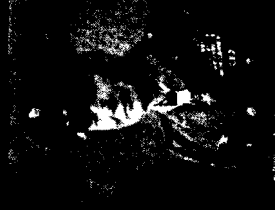

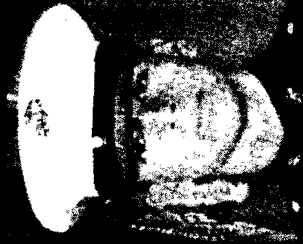
